Dirt Cups

What you need:

- 1 pkg. (3.9 oz.) JELL-O® Chocolate Flavor Instant Pudding

- 2 cups cold milk

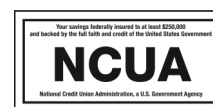
Make It:
